## **2026 Calendar of Important Dates for Broadcasters<sup>1</sup>**

2026 will likely be an eventful one for broadcasters. The FCC will be completing its 2022 Quadrennial Review of the Broadcast Ownership Rules, and quite possibly relaxing the local radio and television ownership rules. In anticipation of these changes, we saw an uptick in broadcast station acquisitions in the last half of 2025, and we anticipate many more transactions if the rules do in fact change. Broadcasters may well want to explore their options now to be ready should the rules change.

This year will also be a very busy political year with the entire House of Representatives up for reelection, one-third of the Senate, 36 Governor races, and many other state and local races. In the 45 days before a primary, and the 60 days before a general election, broadcast stations need to sell advertising to candidates at the lowest unit rate that they sell the same class of time to their best commercial advertiser – giving candidates the benefit of all volume discounts even if they don’t buy in volume. We have included a list of the lowest unit rate (“LUR”) windows for 2026 in this calendar. Please confirm these dates locally as, particularly with municipal and other state and local elections, information can be contradictory and can quickly change. There may also be elections that we have missed in our research putting this calendar together, and because new elections can arise to fill unexpected vacancies in public offices. The calendar lists these LUR windows both at the end of each month’s list of regulatory dates, and in an appendix, where the windows are arranged by state.

Related to LUR, we will be watching a Supreme Court case where the Court will be deciding if political parties can coordinate their political spending with candidates – potentially funneling more money from the parties to the candidates who can purchase spots at the LUR. A decision is expected in this case by June before the Court’s summer recess, so watch to see if the decision has any impact on the elections in the last half of 2026.

We will also be watching the FCC’s *Delete, Delete, Delete* proceeding, where the Commission is looking to abolish unnecessary regulation. In association with that proceeding, the FCC has also been reviewing all sorts of regulatory requirements. In 2025, the FCC suspended Biennial Ownership Reports until at least June 2027, and it postponed until June 2026 certain requirements for broadcasters needing to receive certifications from advertising buyers attesting that they are not representatives of foreign governments before selling issue advertising and paid PSAs. Other filing requirements may be under review, so watch for FCC actions affecting other routine regulations.

In our calendar, we also note some deadlines for SoundExchange submissions of monthly reports and payments, and an increase in the fees for commercial broadcasters who stream. Many of these developments, however, while established in settlements filed with

the Copyright Royalty Board (“CRB”), have not been approved by the Board, though we expect approval soon. Note too that rates for certain webcasters, including non-profit religious broadcasters and commercial webcasters who are not broadcasters, are also expected to be set in a CRB decision that was supposed to have been released by December 15, 2025, but appears to have been delayed by the government shutdown. Look for this and other music royalty developments during the course of the year.

There will no doubt be other issues that arise in 2026, so watch as the FCC and Congress take actions that establish new filing requirements or abolish old ones. In the interim, we offer this calendar of important dates for broadcasters in 2026 – as far as we know them as we write this in late 2025. But check with your own advisors and stay abreast of new developments, as these regulatory dates may well change during the course of the year.

In our calendar, we provide a description of the obligation, the due date, and the place where compliance is required (e.g., through an FCC filing, an addition to the public file). When broadcasters have an obligation to add documents to their station’s Online Public Inspection File (“OPIF”), they must ensure that the required documentation (e.g., the Annual EEO Public Inspection File Report or the Quarterly Issues/Programs Lists) is uploaded to the OPIF by the applicable deadline. The OPIF makes many of these deadlines even more important because interested parties (including the FCC) need no longer visit your station to review whether you have met your public file obligations. Instead, they can review the OPIF anywhere there is an Internet connection and assess your compliance with the various public file obligations. Don’t let your station be caught with an incomplete public file because violations of these rules often lead to FCC fines.

As the year progresses, there will no doubt be other compliance deadlines that arise. <sup>3</sup> For commercial broadcasters, the royalty rate for non-subscription services will go from \$.0025 per performance (a performance being one song transmitted to one listener) in 2025 to \$.0028 per performance for all performances in 2026. These rates were set by a settlement between the NAB and SoundExchange, which has not yet been approved by the Copyright Royalty Board, but that approval is expected soon, as is approval of other settlements setting rates including those for CPB-supported stations and non-profit stations affiliated with educational institutions. Rates for streaming by non-profit entities not associated with NPR or CPB or educational institutions (including most non-profit religious broadcasters) and other webcasters not affiliated with a broadcast company have not been set at the time this calendar was prepared. A decision of the Copyright Royalty Judges setting those rates should be released at any time.
